LOCAL RULES

1. Out of Bounds (Rule 18)

a) Out of bounds is defined by white stakes, painted lines and/or fences bordering the golf course.

2. Penalty Areas (Rule 17)

a) Penalty Areas are defined by yellow/red stakes and/or painted lines.

b) To assist pace of play, Golfers are permitted to play a provisional ball under Rule 18 for a ball that may be in the penalty area on holes 3 & 10.

If not found, the provisional ball becomes in play with a one shot penalty
d) Additional drop zones; as an added option where provided, where a golfer may elect to take relief under a penalty of one shot.

3. Free Relief

Golfers are entitled to free relief when a ball lies in or on an obstruction, or when the obstruction interferes with the player's stance or the area of their intended swing.

a) GUR areas marked with white paint, white rope and/or a GUR sign.

b) Concrete drains, manhole covers, sprinkler heads and control boxes.

c) Artificially made roadways and/or pathways (not including cut grass walkways around tees).

d) Young trees marked with stakes, tree stumps and/or tree roots.

e) Tee signs, directional signage, benches and rubbish bins.

f) Hazard stakes, except when the ball lies within the hazard.

g) Rain shelters, kiosks and halfway huts.

h) Edging grooves around the shoulder of the green.

i) Embedded (plugged) ball through the green, except in a penalty area or bunker.

j) Bird Nesting Hole – inside a bunker (Rule 16b – the ball must be dropped inside the bunker).

k) Wood ties and wood steps around the golf course.

l) Flower beds marked with a blue stake.

m) Glass separation borders in semi rough.
